

Reporting the Death of a Kansas FCE Member

The President of the local FCE or County Council or Area Director should notify the State President and State Treasurer (addresses below) about the death of a Unit Member or Independent Member.

Notification should state, as recorded on the FCE Membership Form, the full name of deceased member, identify name of FCE Unit or an Independent Member, county and area. If available, provide the newspaper obituary notice or the funeral service program. The Notification may be sent by letter or email.
